

What New Yorkers Need to Know About COVID-19 Vaccines

**COVID-19 vaccines are available now for all people age 12 and older.
People ages 12 to 17 can get the Pfizer vaccine only.**



COVID-19 vaccines are safe and effective.

The vaccines went through large clinical studies that showed they are very effective at protecting people from severe COVID-19 illness, hospitalization and death.



COVID-19 vaccines are free. Insurance or sharing immigration status is not required.

No appointment is needed at many sites.



You may experience side effects, such as arm soreness, headache, body aches, tiredness and fever.



Once fully vaccinated, you can do most activities without wearing a face covering or physical distancing anymore! However, our advice is to keep your face covering on indoors until even more people are vaccinated. Also, you must follow the face covering requirements of any place that you go, such as a business, school, public transportation or your workplace.
